RESPONSIBILITIES/DUTIES

- 1. Organize and oversee the children's ministries of the church, including:
 - a. Nursery Ministry
 - b. Children's Worship
 - c. Children's fellowship activities
- 2. Collaborate with the Elder of Education to provide children's bible study opportunities.
- 3. Recruit and train leaders and volunteers for the various children's ministries.
- 4. Research, survey and evaluate the church and community to determine what ministries to children are most needed and if existing ministries are effective.
- 5. Develop new ministries to serve the children of this congregation and community as needed.
- 6. Obtain and supply materials needed for the children's ministries.
- 7. Lead the Children's Ministry Team in creating, developing, implementing and maintaining age-appropriate, mission-aligned ministry for children that involves worship, fellowship, education, and outreach, including our virtual congregation. (This will require collaboration with the leaders of each of these departments.)
- 8. Collaborate with existing ministries in the church which involve children, including but not limited to:
 - a. Children's Ushers
 - b. Children's Choir
 - c. Children's Dance
- 9. Maintain consistent and regular communication with parents of children about all aspects of children's ministries.
- 10. Pray regularly for the children's ministries.
- 11. Create, and Oversee the budget and expenditures for the children's ministries.

- 12. Coordinate with the Director of I.T. Ministries to maintain ministry's section of the church website.
- 13. Responsible for check-in procedures and tracking weekly attendance.
